M. A. Anderson

Heretofore and on the 9th day of December, 1912 came on to be heard the matter of opening the R. W. Garrill road as follows: Beginning at the NE cor. of Sec. 23, T. 12, R. 18, thence W along the N line of said Sec. 23 to the NW cor. of said section 23, thence W along the N line of Sec. 22, T. 12, R. 18, 106 rods. And on said date said road as above described was ordered opened and there was awarded to M. A. Anderson as his damages the sum of \$225.⁰⁰ for the injury done and land taken from him, he being the owner of NW¹ of Sec. 23, T. 12, R. 18, along and thru which said road runs.

And thereafter said M. A. Anderson made application to the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County for a re-hearing as to said allowance of \$225.⁰⁰ as his damages, claiming that said sum did not compensate him fully for the damages sustained on account of the opening of said road and said board granted a rehearing.

And now on this 14th day of January, 1914 the foregoing matter came on for final determination and the board having heard the application of said M. A. Anderson and heard the evidence thereon and being fully advised in the premises it is now on this day ordered that said claim be allowed in the sum of Three Hundred Dollars and the county clerk is hereby directed to issue his warrant to said M. A. Anderson for said sum of \$300.⁰⁰. It is further ordered that the allowance heretofore made of \$225.⁰⁰ be and the same is hereby set aside.
