Proceedings In re- Settlement of an Island in the Kansas River by Guy Grimes of Eudora.

Jan 22 1914. Guy Grimes of Eudora, Kansas filed in this office a plat and survey of a certain island located in the Kansas River, near the city of Eudora, together with his affidavit of Settlement and a bond for \$50.00 signed by John B. Muller as surety, who was duly qualified before Charles A. Hill a Notary Public, the said bond having been this day approved as to form by the Co. Atty and the surety thereon approved by the County Clerk, all the above being accompanied by a statement of the Co. Surveyor showing settlement of the expense of survey and field notes, setting forth kind of soil, acreage etc.

Publication notice as per clip attached hereto was sent to paper for publication.

Further consideration of the above matter continued to February 21.
