To Phi Gamma Delta Frat of Lawrence, \$8³/₄ Per. Prop. tax of 1913 on ac^c of "Excessive Assessment"

The road petitioned for by Warren Ridley and 15 others as described on page 521, was granted, to be laid on the W side of Sec. line of 33-12-14; thence 3 1/4 of a mile to intersect with road running East; said road to be 30 ft. wide.

Changes in the above road matter were allowed to L. P. Baldwin of \$175.00 and the Clerk instructed draw a warrant for the amount and notify the Trustee of Kansas City to open said road.

The matter of a road petitioned for by H. A. Astic was taken under consideration but laid over to some future date.
