Friday, April 17, 1914

Commissioners J. L. Hoover and Luc. H. Brune, in accordance with previous decision of the Board, inspected County roads and bridges in Leecompton and Kanwaka Townships, also investigated the progress of the work being done on Stull Hill, Horn Creek Hill, and roads being graded.

Commissioner J. L. Walton inspected the road grading work in progress in Grant Township.

Saturday, April 18, 1914.

Board met in regular adjourned session with all members present.

In the matter of the purchase of a road grader for use on County roads, the Board decided to purchase a Russell machine on spec of same being a heavier machine and in the judgment of a majority of the Board, more suitable for use on heavy gumbo roads.

In the matter of the petition of R. L. Rober and 52 others for the vacation and relocation of a road described as follows: "To vacate the County Road which begins on the E line of NE⁴ of SE⁴ of Sec. 16, T13, R18E at the point where said County Road turns in a North-westerly direction; thence North-westerly to the north line of the said SE⁴ of Sec 16, T13, R18.

To locate a road, beginning at the bridge about 60 rods S of the N line of SE⁴ of Sec. 16, T13, R18 on the Public Highway which runs in a N and S direction located in the NE⁴ of SE⁴ of said Section and near the E line of said Section; thence in a North-westerly direction to intersect the road running E and W on the N line of said quarter section at the point where said road crosses a bridge about 14 rods W of the E line of said Sec. 16, T13, R18." - the date for viewing same was set for May 15, 1914.

Commissioners J. L. Hoover and Luc. H. Brune reported that all work was progressing satisfactorily in Leecompton
