The report of the Board of Examiners on the condition of the County Treasury was accepted and approved by this Board as follows: (Copy of Report.)
Gentlemen:

Pursuant to your order, made on the 11th day of March, 1914, we, the undersigned, C. E. Lindley, probate judge, S. B. Lawrence, and A. J. Ricker, citizens and tax payers of Douglas County, Kansas, do certify that on the 16th day of March, 1914, we counted the funds in the hands of the county treasurer and found that at the close of business on Saturday, March 14th, 1914, said county treasurer had in his hands in cash, checks, cash vouchers and in various banks, the sum of \$137,907.60. We further certify that we examined the books of said county treasurer from the close of business on the 28th day of March, 1912, being the date of the last examination on record in the office of the county clerk, to the close of business on the 14th day of March, 1914, and found the total receipts during said period to be \$1,046,083.02 and the total disbursements during said period to be \$958,175.42, leaving a balance of \$137,907.60 in the hands of the county treasurer, as above stated.
