Board issued an order, authorizing the co. clerk to instruct the Treasurer to cancel 1913 Tax against "4 a long description near SW cor of SW 26-44-20" also instructing the co. clerk to strike the above description and valuation from the 1914 Assessment Roll, on account of "double assessment"

Board granted the petition of Cornelius Scott asking that the land described as "Sub divisions 8th and 10 of Prairie City, Vacated" be stricken from the Assessment Rolls of Douglas County and the taxes against said property for the years 1912nd and 1913 be cancelled, and the co. clerk was instructed accordingly.

Board issued the following resolution and instructed the co. clerk to enter a copy of same on the minutes as follows:

"Whereas, in view of the fact that the General Fund of the County is not sufficient to pay all warrants drawn against it for the year ending Nov. 1st, 1914, therefore be it Resolved, that in order to save interest charges on the unpaid warrants we request the County Treasurer to pay those warrants and stamp same Not Paid for Want of Funds but carry same as cash item until such time as taxes are paid in to cover them."
