A contract was entered into with Orley M. Smith to furnish coal for the Court House and Jail for the coming year as follows: copy:— This agreement entered into this 29th day of August, 1914 by Orley M. Smith, party of the first part, and the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, party of the second part, witnesseth that the said Orley M. Smith, party of the first part, hereby contracts to and with said Board of County Commissioners, to furnish and deliver coal to the said Board of County Commissioners, for the year beginning September 1st, 1914 as follows, to wit:

Best grade of deep shaft Cherokee Lump coal for use in the Douglas County Court House and the Douglas County Jail, in Lawrence, at the rate of Four and no/100 Dollars (\$4.00) per ton delivered at said Court House and Jail; enough coal to be delivered by October 15, 1914 to fill the bins, in both said buildings, and further deliveries for these places to be made whenever directed by the Board of County Commissioners.
