The following petition by R. E. French for an extension of time to comply with a certain contract was granted upon the conditions stated therein.

TO THE HONORABLE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF DOUGLAS COUNTY, KANSAS

The undersigned, your petitioner, hereby represents to your honorable body, that with reference to a certain contract dated July 13, 1914, in which he agrees to deliver and furnish P.O.B. Lawrence, the material for joists to be used on Wakarusa Bridge at Mair's crossing, within ninety (90) days from the above date i.e., July 13, 1914, the said contract requiring this material to be delivered not later than October 13th, 1914, and

Your petitioner further represents that for reasons beyond his control he is unable to comply with the requirements of said contract as to date of delivery, only.

Your petitioner therefore respectfully prays that your honorable body extend the time of delivery of the said material for a period not to exceed sixty (60) days from the date last mentioned, all of the remainder of the said contract to remain and be in full force and effect the same as though no change in the date of delivery of the said material had been made;

Your petitioner further represents, promises, and agrees that in consideration of the extension of time prayed for herein, if allowed by your honorable body, he will personally apply to the Southwestern Surety Insurance Company of Oklahoma at their office in Kansas City, Missouri, and arrange the continuance of their bond of \$437.00, given for the proper performance of the provisions of the aforesaid contract between R. E. French and Douglas County, Kansas, the said continuance to cover every provision in said contract including the extending of the date of delivery of said material to a date sixty (60) days from October 13th, 1914.
