The following resolution was presented and passed:-
 Resolution Providing for the Issue of Twenty-six Thousand Dollars Refunding Bonds of the County of Douglas, in the State of Kansas.

Whereas, The County of Douglas in the State of Kansas, has outstanding its bonds to the amount of twenty-six thousand (\$26,000.00) dollars dated January 2nd, 1905, and payable January 1st, 1915, bearing interest at four per cent per annum and,

Whereas, The said bonds have been issued and outstanding for more than two years at the time of the passing of this resolution and,

Whereas, The said County desires to refund said bonds, therefore,

Be It Resolved, By the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas;

First: that the Chairman and Clerk are hereby authorized to have prepared and executed under the seal of the County, fifty-two (52) refunding bonds of Five Hundred (\$500.00) dollars each numbered from one (1) to fifty-two (52) inclusive, dated the 2nd day of January, 1915, and payable the 2nd day of January, 1918, bearing interest evidenced by coupons attached at the rate of five (5%) per centum per annum, on the 2nd days of July and January of each year, both principal and interest of said bonds to be made payable at the State Treasurer's office of the State of Kansas.

Second, That the bonds and coupons thereto attached shall be in substantially the following form, to-wit:

Know All Men By These Presents, That the County of Douglas in the State of Kansas acknowledges to owe, and for value received, promises to pay the Bearer Five Hundred (\$500.00) dollars, lawful money of the United States of America, on the Second day of January, A.D. 1918, with interest thereon from the date hereof until paid, at the rate of five (5) per centum per annum, payable semi annually on the 2nd day of July and January in each year upon presentation and surrender of the annexed interest coupons as they severally become due. Both principal and interest of this bond are payable at the State Treasurer's office of the State of Kansas.
