This bond is one of a series of fifty-two (52) bonds of like date, maturity and tenor, numbered from one (1) to fifty-two (52) inclusive, issued by said county for the purpose of refunding a like amount of outstanding bonded indebtedness heretofore legally created by said county and which has been outstanding over two (2) years, and is issued under and by authority of and in accordance with an act of the Legislature of the State of Kansas entitled "An act to enable counties, municipal corporations, the boards of education of any city, and school districts, to refund their indebtedness, which took effect March 10th, 1879, and all amendments thereto, and also of a resolution legally and duly passed by the Board of County Commissioners of said county.

And it is hereby certified and recited that all acts, conditions and things required to be done precedent to and in the issuing of this bond, have been properly done, happened, and been performed in regular and due form and time as required by law, and that the indebtedness refunded into this bond was and is a valid, subsisting and binding obligation of the said county, and that the total indebtedness of the said county including this bond, does not exceed any constitutional or statutory limitations.

In Testimony Whereof, We, the undersigned officers of the County of Douglas in the State of Kansas, being duly authorized to execute this obligation on its behalf, have hereunto set our official signatures and caused the seal of said county to be hereunto affixed the second day of January, A.D. 1915.
