Whereas, it appears to this Board that the following described real estate, and personal property in Wakarusa Township has been erroneously assessed and taxed in School District #60 instead of School District #81 where it rightfully belongs.

Therefore Be it Resolved:- That we the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, at a regular meeting, assembled do hereby authorize the County Clerk to change the following described real estate and personal property in Wakarusa Township from School District #60 into School District #81 on the Assessment Rolls of 1914 and we further authorize the County Clerk to instruct the County Treasurer to cancel or refund the difference in Tax between School District #60 and School District #81 on the following described real estate, and personal property:-
