

Monday, January 4, 1915.

The Board met in regular session with J. L. Hoover, Chairman; Gus H. Bunn and W. R. Green present.

Claims against the County were examined and allowed as per allowance record.

Mr. J. D. Fincher appeared in person before the Board for the cancellation of the tax on \$225⁰⁰/₁₀₀ amounting to \$4³⁴/₁₀₀. Said \$225⁰⁰/₁₀₀ being the value of improvements on property in North Lawrence described on page 222 line 22 of 1914 Assessment Rolls. Said Mr. J. D. Fincher declaring that there were no improvements on this property. Board allowed the claim of Mr. J. D. Fincher and instructed the County Clerk to issue an order on the County Treasurer to cancel the said taxes amounting to \$4³⁴/₁₀₀.

Mr. C. H. McLarin appeared in person before the Board for the cancellation of the tax on \$200⁰⁰/₁₀₀ amounting to \$3⁸⁶/₁₀₀. Said \$200⁰⁰/₁₀₀ being the exemption Mr. C. H. McLarin is entitled to by law. Board allowed the claim and instructed the County Treasurer to cancel the said taxes amounting to \$3⁸⁶/₁₀₀.

Frank Potter appeared in person before the Board for a Refund of the tax on \$200⁰⁰/₁₀₀ amounting to \$3⁸⁶/₁₀₀ in behalf of Mrs. C. E. Potter. Said \$200⁰⁰/₁₀₀ being the exemption Mrs. C. E. Potter is entitled to by law. Board allowed the claim and instructed the County Clerk to issue a Refund Warrant on the County Treasurer for \$3⁸⁶/₁₀₀.
