against the property now owned by Mrs. Mary A. Mayer, and charged to the owner of the property for the respective years, as follows: 1908, R.P. Washington, \$13.46; 1909, R.P. Washington, \$13.09; 1910, Hattie Parsons and husband, \$12.80; 1911 Charles M. Brown, \$12.97; and

Whereas, the taxes that should have been assessed against the above mentioned parties cannot now be legally assessed against Mrs. Mary A. Mayer or made a lien upon the land.

Now, therefore, Be It Resolved that the County Clerk and Treasurer be and the same are hereby instructed to make such corrections on the records of this County as will properly assess the taxes of the property first described for the years that such property has been omitted from the tax-rolls of Douglas County, and that in consideration of the payment of Seven and ⁵⁰/₁₀₀ Dollars (\$7.50) per year for the years 1908, 1909, 1910, and 1911 by Mrs. Mary A. Mayer, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, the taxes for those years be shown on the records as paid in full and the following described land in Douglas County, Kansas, to wit:

Commencing at a point Twenty (20) rods west of the North-east Corner of the South One-half ($\frac{1}{2}$) of the North-west Quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) of the South-west Fractional Quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Twenty-nine (29), Township Twelve (12), Range Twenty (20); thence west Eight (8) rods; thence south Twenty (20) rods; thence east Eight (8) rods; thence north Twenty (20) rods to beginning, be released from any and all claims or liens of the County for taxes accumulating prior to 1912.

Done by the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Douglas, State of Kansas, in regular session, on the 7 day of January, 1915.
