The Board met in regular adjourned session with all members present.

The Board took up the matter of Official Paper and voted to designate The Lawrence Daily Journal World as the Official Paper for the year.

The Lawrence Daily Journal-World submitted the following proposition on the County Printing.

To meet any proposition that may be made to you by papers of less circulation, we are willing to take the printing upon the basis of 1 cent a line per 1000 words circulation for the publication of Commissioners' proceedings, and 2 cents a line per 1000 of words circulation for other matter, not including the tax list, which charge is made by law and which costs the County nothing as it is charged directly against the property. Or we will take the printing at one-half legal rate (5 cents per line for Commissioners' proceedings; and legal rates (10 cents per line) for other matter, not including tax lists. Moreover our regular commercial rate for reading matter is 10 cents per line.
