The Lawrence Printing and Publishing Co submitted a proposition along the same lines as that submitted by the Lawrence Daily Journal-World but with an additional discount of 250¢.

The vote on the above propositions was as follows:-

For the proposition of the Lawrence Journal-World - Geo. H. Bruner, and W. R. Grant.

For the proposition of the Lawrence Printing and Publishing Co - J. L. Horrod.

The Board authorized the County Clerk to instruct the County Treasurer to charge the various Townships of the County with their respective portions of the Primary and General Election expense for the year 1914 as follows:-
