Board's next in regular adjourned session with all members present.

Claims against the county were allowed as per allowance record.

Board selected Hedrick & Cochran, of Kansas City, Mo. as consulting engineers for the new concrete bridge to be erected at Lawrence over the Kaw river and entered into the following agreement:

This Agreement, made this 3rd day of March A. D. 1915, by and between the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, parties of the first part and Hedrick and Cochran, Consulting Engineers, of Kansas City, Missouri, parties of the second part.

Witnesseth:

1st. The parties of the second part hereby agree that for and in consideration of the sum of five (5%) per cent of the total cost of the bridge to be built over the Kansas River at Lawrence, Kansas, said total cost not to exceed Two Hundred Thousand (\$200,000.00) dollars and the amount to be paid to the said Hedrick & Cochran not to exceed Ten Thousand (\$10,000.00), they will perform the following work in connection with the design and construction of said bridge namely,

(a). To make a complete survey of the proposed site or sites to determine the best location for the structure and to locate all piers, pedestals, abutments and retaining walls constituting a part of said bridge or its approaches.
