Kanabek and Grant Township.

No changes made.

Tuesday May 18, 1915.

Leamington and Clinton Township.

Board reduced the improvements from \$2,500.00 to \$1,800.00 on SW¹/₄ Section 35, Township 13, Range 17, School District #60 etc.

C.F. Mero of Marion Township claims he has 125 head of cattle that were assessed at \$40.00 a head and should be \$30.00. Board postponed action.

Wednesday May 19, 1915.

Marion and Willow Springs Township.

Board reduced the improvements from \$1,000.00 to \$300.00 on SW¹/₄ less 51 ²/₃ in 6 parts, Section 13, Township 15, Range 19, Willow Springs Township.

Thursday May 20, 1915.

Palmyra Township v. Baldwin City.

John W. Fisher who owns lot 122 ¹²⁴ King street Baldwin City applied to board for reduction in improvements. After investigation & correspondence by the county clerk with the former & present assessors claim was rejected because the residence stands on both lots and is not now assessed.
