Board instructed Co. Clerk to issue refunding Warrants for \$1.25 to Chas. Antrell
and to Mrs A. C. Mitchell \$2.35 on allowance for paving tax.

Thursday September 9th 1915

Board met in regular adjourned session all members present.
Claims against the County were allowed as per allowance record.
In regard to Section (i) on pp. 57, 58, 59 and 60 of the
Specifications for the Kansas River bridge at Lawrence,
which said section sets forth the provisions regarding payments
to the Contractor for the work done under the contract,
Be it (Resolved) by the Board of County Commissioners
of Douglas County, in regular session, this the 9th day of September, 1915,
that the said Section (i) shall be amended and changed in the
following particulars:

1. The Commissioners guarantee that they will make
the tax levies authorized by Law and will collect the tax
monies to the full amount of 200,000 dollars authorized by
Law, provided such an amount is needed to pay for the work.
2. The Commissioners agree that, if at any time
the amount in the County Treasury to the credit of the bridge
fund is insufficient to pay the engineering expenses and the
Contractor's estimate, they will arrange with local banking
institutions to advance funds in anticipation of the tax collections,
sufficient to pay the said engineering expenses and the Contractor's estimate.
3. The successful bidder will not be required to
enter into a contract to build and fully complete the structure
unless there is definite assurance that there will be sufficient
funds to pay for the work.

Be it (Resolved) further, that these resolutions
shall be, and are hereby made, a part of the specifications;
that a copy be attached to the copy of the specification and filed in the
office of the County Clerk, and that a copy be sent to each party
to whom the plans and specifications have been or will be sent.
