

thence South 30 rods, to where said line intersects the North line of North Lawrence, known as North Street, thence west along the center line of North Street, to a point where 4th St. North intersects the center line of said North St. thence South on the center line of 4th St. North to the South line of Lot No 16 Addition No. 4 in North Lawrence, thence West along the South line of Lot No 6 and Lot No 5 of said addition to the center line of 3rd Street North, thence South on the center line of said 3rd St. North, to the South line of Lot 6 Addition No. 4 North Lawrence, thence West along the South line of said Lot No 6, to the D. W. Jones of said Lot No 6, thence South on the center line of the Block between 2nd St. North and 3rd St. North to the center of 2nd St., thence West on the center line of 2nd St. to the place of beginning.

Our petitioners aver that all the lands above described, and which they desire to incorporate into a drainage district, are subject to damage and injury from causes hereinbefore named (i.e.) overflow from the Kansas River, and Dead Creek, also surface water.

The construction and maintenance of levees, drains, or other works are necessary to prevent such damage; and that such improvements will be conducive to the public health, convenience and welfare.

Wherefore, our petitioners pray that the Honorable Board of County Commissioners, hereinbefore mentioned, grant their said petition, and that the territory and lands mentioned and described in this petition be incorporated into a Drainage District, to be known as The Maple Grove Drainage District, for the reasons and purposes therein described and mentioned.
