

thence southwards to where said line intersects the North line of North Lawrence, known as North Street, thence west along the center line of North Street, to a point where 1<sup>st</sup> St. North intersects the center line of said North St., thence north on the center line of 1<sup>st</sup> St. North to the South line of Lot No. 16, Addition No. 1 in North Lawrence, thence West along the South line of Lot No. 16 and Lot No. 5 of said addition to the center line of 3rd Street, North, thence South on the center line of said 3rd St. North to the South line of Lot 6, Addition No. 1, North Lawrence, thence West along the South line of said Lot No. 6, to the S. W. corner of said Lot No. 6, thence South on the center line of the Brook between 2nd and 3rd St., North to the center of 2nd St., thence West in the center line of 2nd St. to the place of beginning.

Our petitioners aver that all the lands above described, and which they desire to incorporate into a drainage district, are subject to damage and injury from causes hereinbefore mentioned, i.e., overflow from the Genesee River, and Head Creek also surface water. The construction and maintenance of levees, drains, or other works are necessary to prevent such damage; and that such improvements will be conducive to the public health, convenience and welfare.

Wherefore, our petitioners pray that the Honorable Board of County Commissioners, hereinbefore mentioned, grant their said petition, and that the territory and lands, mentioned and described in this petition be incorporated into a Drainage District to be known as The Maple Grove Drainage District, for the reasons and purposes herein described and mentioned.
