

This agreement entered into this 25th day of May, A.D. 1915, by and between L. H. Menger of the first Part and the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, party of the Second Part,

Witnesseth, that whereas the said County of Douglas is about to build a concrete bridge over the Kansas River at a point immediately West of the present steel bridge across said river in the City of Lawrence.

Now therefore, for the purpose of securing a right of way for said new bridge, it is agreed by and between the parties hereto that when said bridge is completed by the parties of the Second Part that the said L. H. Menger will quit-claim unto said County as much as Lots Nos 23-25-27-29 on Bridge Street in the City of Lawrence, as is necessary for the construction of said bridge as per the plat by E. L. Dammie City Engineer of the City of Lawrence showing the location of the new bridge and raise of grade allowing a variation of eight feet from the location shown on said plat.

The Compensation for the above named Contract and agreement shall be One (\$1.00) Dollar to be paid in the party of the First Part by the party of the Second Part and an agreement to maintain a sidewalk on the West side of the bridge over the land quit-claimed by said party of the first part.

In further consideration of the above named items the party of the first part hereby agree to permit the party of the Second Part or their agents or employees to enter upon and use the said Lots Nos 23-25-27 and 29 on Bridge Street for the purpose of placing material during the construction of said bridge or making grade for the North approach of said bridge -
