Know All Men By These Presents that

Whereas, on the first day of January, 1910, the County of Douglas in the State of Kansas, issued a series of municipal bonds known as the Douglas County Refunding Bonds, due January 1, 1916, said bonds in said series being numbered from 1 to 25 inclusive, each for the sum of \$1000⁰⁰, bearing interest at the rate of four and one half per cent. per annum, payable semi-annually, and

Whereas, said bonds were by the County of Douglas aforesaid duly sold and delivered to diverse persons, and

Whereas, among others, Alexander Monroe of Lawrence, Kansas, in the due course of business, became the purchaser^{2d} owner of Bond No. 4 of said series for the sum of One Thousand Dollars, with interest as aforesaid and payable as aforesaid, and is now the owner of the same, and was in possession of said Bond No. 4 until shortly after the first day of January, A D 1915, and was placed among the papers of the said Alexander Monroe and kept in said papers until shortly prior to January 1, 1915, and

Whereas, when the said Alexander Monroe searched among said papers shortly prior to the first day of July, 1915, for said bond for the purpose of clipping the coupon for the same falling due on July 1, 1915 and presenting the same for payment, he discovered that said bond was missing and that the same had been lost, and

Whereas, he has upon diverse occasions since said date diligently searched for the same among all of his said papers, and in places where his papers were and are usually kept, and after such diligent search he has been unable to find said bond and upon his best information and belief says that the same has been lost and destroyed, and

Whereas, the County of Douglas is perfectly willing to pay the said Alexander Monroe the full face value of said bond, together with the accrued interest thereon from January 1, 1915 to January 1, 1916, provided that the said Monroe shall fully indemnify and save harmless the said County of Douglas from any and all damages of all kinds and character which the said County of Douglas might sustain in case said bond were found
