Now, Therefore, we, Alexander Monroe and M. Newmark, C. H. Tucker as sureties are held and firmly bound unto the County of Douglas in the state of Kansas in the sum of Two Thousand Dollars lawful money of the United States of America, to be paid to the said County of Douglas for which payment well and truly to be made we bind ourselves, our heirs, executors and administrators jointly and severally by these presents.

Signed by us on this 15 day of January A. D. 1916.

The condition of this obligation is such that Whereas, one certain Douglas County Refunding Bond issued by the County of Douglas aforesaid, bearing date January 1, 1910 in the sum of One Thousand Dollars, with interest thereon at the rate of four and one half per cent per annum, payable January 1, 1916, has been lost or destroyed, said bond being No. 4,

Now, Therefore, if the said Alexander Monroe and M. Newmark & C. H. Tucker shall well and truly save harmless and fully indemnify the said County of Douglas aforesaid against all claims by any other person or persons on account of said bond and against all costs and expenses by reason of such claim, then this obligation is to be void otherwise to be and remain in full force and effect.

Notice is hereby given that on the eighth day of January, 1916, a petition signed by Henry L. and thirteen others, was filed with the board of county commissioners of the county and state praying for the change of road, described as follows:

Vacating the road as located from a point 60 or 65 of the corner of sections 22 and 22, T. 12 S.
