Notice is hereby given that on the eighth day of January, 1916, a petition signed by Henry Bahnmair and thirteen others, was presented to the board of county commissioners of the county and state aforesaid, praying for the change of a certain road, described as follows, viz:

Vacating the road as now traveled from a point 60 or 65 rods west of the corner of sections 15, 16, 21 and 22, T. 12 S. R. 18 E, running thence southwesterly and south of the line between sections 16 and 21, 30 or 35 rods, and northwesterly back to the line between sections 16 and 21 near the N. W. corner of N. E. 1/4 of Sec. 21; and to establish and locate said road on the line between said sections 16 and 21 between the beginning and end of the road vacated on line of Kanwaka and Lecompton townships.
