It is further ordered that an election be held on the 18th day of April, 1916, at W. J. Cummings, Jr. Residence in SW 4 the same being within the limits of said Drainage District, for the purpose of electing three directors for said corporation.

It is further ordered that L. T. Steel, John J. Tobler, and F. J. Buchheim tax-payers residing within said District, be and they are hereby appointed judges of said election, and that L. H. Petefish & Lewis Simpson tax-payers residing within said District are hereby appointed clerks of said election.

Drainage District Notice.

In the Matter of the Clinton, Kanawaka, and Wakarusa Drainage District of Douglas County, Kansas.

Now on this 4th day of April, 1916 the petition for the organization and incorporation of a drainage district to be known as the Clinton, Kanawaka and Wakarusa Drainage District of Douglas County, Kansas, came on for hearing the same having been adjourned from the 4th day of March, 1916, and it appearing to the Board of County Commissioners that notice has been given of the time of the hearing as required by law, and the said board having heard the evidence of all persons in favor of or opposed to granting the prayer of said petition and being fully advised in the premises, and it further appearing that said petition contains the proper number of signatures possessing the qualifications prescribed by law, and that the allegations of said petition are true.

It is therefore ordered by the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, that the territory described in said petition constitute a public corporation, and the inhabitants with such bounds be incorporated in a drainage district under the name of The Clinton, Kanawaka and Wakarusa Drainage District of Douglas County, Kansas, and that thenceforth the following described territory,

Begin at the southwest corner of the northwest quarter of Section 30, Township 13, Range 18; thence east on the quarter section line to the southeast corner of the northeast quarter of Section 29, Township 13, Range 18; thence north on the section line to the northeast corner of said Section 29; thence east on the section line to the northeast corner of Section 28, Township 13, Range 18; thence north on the section line to the northeast corner of the southeast quarter of Section 16, Township 13, Range 18; thence east on the quarter section line to the northeast corner of the west half of the southwest quarter of Section 14; thence south to the southeast corner of the west half of the southwest quarter of said Section 14; thence east on the section line to the north east corner of the west half of the northwest quarter of Section 19, Township 13, Range 19; thence south to the southeast corner of the west half of the northwest quarter of Section 19; thence east to the southeast corner of the northeast quarter of Section 19; thence north to the northeast corner of the southeast quarter of Section 19; thence south to the southeast corner of the northwest quarter of Section 21, Township 13, Range 19; thence north to the northeast corner of the northwest quarter of said Section 21; thence east on the section line to the northeast corner of the northwest quarter of the west quarter of Section 22, Township 13, Range 19; thence due north to the northeast corner of the northwest quarter of the northwest quarter of Section 15, Township 13, Range 19; thence west to the southwest corner of Section 7, Township
