Beginning at the S. E. cor. of the N. E. ⁴/₄ the N. E. cor. of the S. E. ⁴/₄ of Sec. 32-12-18 thence running due west to creek, described as the road lying ⁴/₄ viewing east and west between the N. E. ⁴/₄ and the S. E. ⁴/₄ of Sec. 32-12-18.

Contract

This Agreement made and signed this 5th day of April Nineteen Hundred and Sixteen, by and between the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, first party, and "The Kansas City Kaw Valley & Western Railway Co.," a corporation under the laws of the State of Kansas, second party, Witnesseth:

1. The first party having been duly authorized by the Legislature of the State of Kansas, and by a vote of the people of Douglas County, to construct a reinforced concrete bridge and its approaches across the Kaw River at Lawrence, Kansas, and construction of the same now being under way, hereby agree that it may be used immediately upon completion by the second party for the purpose of conveying its interurban cars across the Kaw River; and the first party for and in consideration of the payments and conditions hereinafter stipulated, hereby
