Whereas, Jacob Shuler, E. L. Flooy, W. J. Harwood, W. C. Harwood and W. W. Hegemann, have filed an application with the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, asking that three appraisers be appointed to appraise the school house in School District #38,

Now Therefore, we the undersigned, acknowledge ourselves to be firmly held and bound unto the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County Kansas, in the penal sum of Twenty-five (\$25.00) Dollars, for the payment of which we well and truly bind ourselves.

The condition of this bond is such, that if the appraisers appointed by the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, shall well and truly appraise the value of the school house in District #38, and if the electors in said district vote to change the site of said school house as per the provisions of Section #7410 of the 1909 Statutes, then this bond shall be void and of no effect, otherwise to remain in full force and effect.
