RURAL HIGH SCHOOL DISTRICT

The following petition filed in the County Clerk's office May 9, was taken up by the Board:-

PETITION FOR RURAL HIGH SCHOOL ²⁰/₁₀₀ BOND ELECTION.

To the Honorable The Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas:-

We, the undersigned, legal electors residing in a territory containing not less than sixteen square miles and comprising Twenty four ¹/₂ and one half square miles (22 ¹/₂ sq. miles in Palmyra township ¹/₂ and two sq. miles in Wakarusa township) in Douglas County, Kansas, being desirous of establishing a rural high school district in conformity with the provisions of House Bill No. 36, of the Session Laws of Kansas of 1915, do hereby petition your honorable body to call a special election for the purpose of voting on the proposition of establishing and locating a rural high school, and to vote bonds for the
