Road Notice.
Notice is hereby given that on June 9, 1916, a petition signed by F. M. Hartman and seven others was presented to the Board of county commissioners of Douglas county, Kansas, praying for the vacation of a certain road in said county, described as follows:
Beginning on the south line of Douglas county, where the south east corner of section thirteen, in township fifteen and the southwest corner of section eighteen, township fifteen range eighteen touch said county line, and running thence north one mile between said sections thirteen and eighteen to the northeast corner of said section thirteen and the northwest corner of said section eighteen. Except, that part of said road beginning at the said county line of Douglas county, and running north from that point twenty-five rods.

The said Board of county commissioners will meet in conjunction with the County Surveyor at the place of beginning, to wit, at a point twenty-five rods north of the south line of Douglas county on the road running between sections thirteen and eighteen, township fifteen range eighteen, on Friday, July 11, 1916, and proceed to view said road.

Beginning on the South line of Douglas County where the southeast corner of Sec 13 in Twp 15th and the southwest corner of Sec 18 in Twp 15 Range 18 touch said county line and running thence north one mile between said sections thirteen and eighteen to the northeast corner of said section thirteen and the northwest corner of said section eighteen for a more particular and minute description of said road, reference is made to Road Record, #3, pages 122 and 123, being a part of Road #327 therein described.

Except, that part of said road begin at said county line of Douglas county, and running north from that point 25 rods.

The Board designated Friday July 14, as the date of viewing.
