

To the Honorable Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, State of Kansas.
Gentlemen:-

Pursuant to your order, dated April 12th, 1916, the undersigned, C. E. Lindley, Probate Judge of Douglas County, Kansas, and George H. Lothholz and G. A. Migliario, citizens and tax-payers of Douglas County, Kansas, appointed as assistants to the Probate Judge, have examined the books of the County Treasurer from the close of business on March 26th, 1915, to the close of business on May 11th, 1916. This examination consisted of a careful footing of all receipts and disbursements between the dates above mentioned. We also counted the cash in the hands of the treasurer and verified all balances in the various banks. From such examination we find:
