BOARD OF EQUALIZATION

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Proceedings had by the Tax Commission
in regular session at its office in
the State House, in Topeka, on June
21st, 1916.

In the matter of the reconvening of
the county board of equalization of
Douglas county.

In accordance with an application made
by the county clerk of the county of Douglas, in which
good reasons are set forth, it is hereby on this 21st
day of June, 1916, by the Tax Commission.

ORDERED, That W. R. Green, Gus. H. Brune
and J. L. Hoover, members of the board of county commis-
sioners of the county of Douglas be and they hereby are
directed to reconvene as the county board of equaliza-
tion of the said county of Douglas on the morning of
June 24th for the purpose of readjusting the percent-
ages of increases or decreases on farm lands as the
case may be ordered at the previous session by the
county board; and such reconvened session shall
close on the evening of June 24th, when the board
as so reconvened shall adjourn sine die.

The secretary will transmit a certified copy of
this order to the county clerk of the county of Douglas
who is directed to enter the same in full upon his
record of the proceedings of the county board of equalization.
