The following letter was taken up by the Board:

This is to certify that in assessing the land of Mrs. R. P. Washington (E² of N⁶ of 26-14-20) a clerical error was made by me. I meant to assess this land at \$25 per acre instead of \$45. Therefore the assessment should be \$2000 for the land and \$1000 for the improvements. The total assessment would then be \$3000 instead of \$4600.
