Road Notice.

State of Kansas, Douglas County:

Notice is hereby given that on September 9, 1916, a petition signed by George E. Coghill and fifteen others was presented to the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, praying for the location of a road in said county described as follows:

Beginning at a point in road Number 212, 9 and 40-100 chains east and 6 and 90-100 chains north of the southwest corner of section thirty-six (36), township twelve (12), south of range nine (19) east, thence east twenty (20) rods more or less, thence northeasterly twenty (20) rods, more or less, to connect with a road or street between lots three, four, five, six, seven, eight, thirteen, fourteen, and fifteen, on the north and lots sixteen to twenty-two inclusive on the south in University Heights, Part two, thence along said road or street and terminating at a public road along the west side of the State University grounds.

Whereupon said board of county commissioners appointed the following named persons, viz: W. R. Green, Gus. H. Brune, J. L. Hoover, as viewers, with instructions to meet, in conjunction with the county surveyor, at the place of beginning of said road in Wakarusa township, on Friday, October 13, 1916, and proceed to view said road and to give all parties a hearing.

Beginning at a point in road # 212, 9 ⁴⁰/₁₀₀ ch. E. and 6 ⁹⁰/₁₀₀ ch. N. of SW cor of Sec 36 T12S, R19E, thence E 20 R more or less, thence northeasterly 20 R more or less to connect with a road or street between lots 3-4-5-6-7-8-13-14 and 15 on the N. & lots 16 to 22 inclusive on the S in University Heights, Part Two, thence along said road or street and terminating at a Public Road along the W side of the State University Grounds.

The Board designated October 13 as the date for viewing.
