AGREEMENT

This Agreement made in duplicate this 7th day of October, 1916, by and between the County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, of the first part, hereinafter called the Commissioners, and The Missouri and Kansas Telephone Company, a corporation, of the second part, hereinafter called The Telephone Company, Witnesseth:
