

Before the County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas
To the State Agricultural College of Manhattan, Kansas,
Engineering Department:

Whereas there is a movement on foot to establish a permanent road between Fort Riley and Leavenworth, Kansas, and

Whereas the citizens of Douglas County desire that said road pass through the City of Lawrence and said part of Douglas County, and

Whereas certain roads have been tentatively designated by Shawnee and Leavenworth Counties as parts of said road, and

Whereas Douglas County desires to make a connection between the roads designated by Shawnee and Leavenworth Counties, and

Whereas it is necessary to have surveys, maps, and estimates made for the use of the United States Government before Federal aid can be secured;

Now Therefore be it ordered by the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Douglas that the engineering department of the Agricultural College at Manhattan, Kansas be and is hereby requested to make said surveys, maps and estimates for that portion of the road which will lie in Douglas County, Kansas and that the results of said survey and estimates be incorporated in the report made by the said engineering department to the United States Government at Washington.
