Resolution

of the Board of County Commissioners appointing and Ordaining a Small Debtor's Court for Douglas County, Kansas.

Whereas it appears that the statements made in the attached application of O. W. Weber for appointment as small debtor's judge are true, and that there is a necessity for the establishment of a small debtor's court in the County of Douglas, Kansas; and

Whereas we find the said O. W. Weber to be a person fit for the duties of such office,

Now Therefore We The Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County do ordain and establish the small debtor's court of Douglas County by virtue of the powers vested in us by law and by further exercise of such powers do appoint O. W. Weber as judge of said Court as by law provided and to hold such office during the pleasure of aforesaid Board and for a term not exceeding four years.

The Lawrence Water Company, and J. H. Mitchell, Receiver of the Lawrence Water Company, hereby notify you that the amount legally due from said Company as tax on the personal property in your Company for the year 1916 does not exceed the sum of \$747.⁰⁰ which sum you have refused to receive, and that said Company and said Receiver now pay the sum of \$699.⁸⁶ demanded by you, protesting against the illegality thereof, and solely to avoid the issue of legal process for its collection; and said Company and Receiver notify you that they will hold you and your County liable
