Agreement, made and executed in duplicate by and between The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company, a Kansas corporation, hereinafter called the Railway Company, party of the first part, and The Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, a body corporate and politic, organized and existing under the laws of the State of Kansas, hereinafter called the County, party of the second part;

Recitals:

The County is constructing a reinforced concrete bridge across the Kansas River at Lawrence, Kansas, consisting of six 132 foot spans in the river proper with a shorter span of a different type on four supports at the south end of said bridge crossing over the right of way and tracks of the Railway Company.

In consideration of the building of said bridge across its right of way and tracks the Railway Company agrees to contribute toward the cost of that portion of said bridge extending over its right of way and tracks, the sum of Fourteen Thousand Three Hundred and Fifty-nine and 19/100 Dollars (\$14,359.19) to be paid upon the completion of said bridge.
