

Wednesday, February 14 - 1917 -

The Board met in regular adjourned session, all members present & Commissioner J. L. Hoover presiding.

Upon motion of Commissioner Andrew, Mr. P. L. McAlpine designated as Kansas City, Mo., was agreed upon to supervise the reconstruction of the bridge across the Kansas river at Eudora. The clerk was instructed to notify the Board of Commissioners of Linn County to the effect.

The board considered the applications of Dr. F. Phillips, Appoint
B. Physician, & Rudolph for County Physician, & appointed Dr. Phillips.

For Superintendent of Road work the applications of C. G. Hines, Appoint
Superintendent Jesse E. Pieratt, J. E. Mead & B. F. Hines were read & the ballot
A. Hines resulting in the selection of Mr. Hines. He was accordingly declared elected to that position.

E. A. Contratto's application for County road plunger was read. Appoint
Road Plunger & upon motion he was unanimously selected for that post.

The clerk was instructed to cancel the Robinson estate tax Canal tax levied in Grant Township & that the same be stricken off the rolls from that taxing district.

The board authorized the institution of the sand system on Audgdon County road work.

Thursday, February 17 - 1917 -

The Board of County Commissioners met in adjourned session, with all members present and J. L. Hoover presiding.

The board authorized the clerk to advertise for bids for the construction of reinforced concrete abutments for the Brown Iron bridge. And approved the following notice therefor:

Notice to Bidders,

Sealed bids will be received at the office of the County Clerk of Douglas County, Kansas, for the construction of the reinforced concrete abutments for what is known as the Brown Iron bridge until 12:00 o'clock noon of Saturday, March 2nd, 1917.

Each bid shall be accompanied by a certified check for \$50.00.
