Said Gertrude McPheters being a daughter of Clark McPheters. Her estate was turned over to the County Treasurer, by him to be covered into the general fund of the county, and to receipt to Ed. S. Harvey for the same.

Commissioner & Chairman J. L. Horner and County Attorney J. D. Wilson drove to Caskulosa, Jefferson County, shortly before noon & spent the day in conference with the Jefferson County board of Commissioners in an effort to adjust the differences with reference to the cost of the up-keep of what is known as the Leamington bridge, a joint bridge, the bills for which up-keep have been paid by Douglas County.

J. E. Cook of Manhattan presented plans & data for the proposed road surface highway which it is proposed shall connect Topeka on the west & Kansas City on the east, and which traverses Douglas County from the west county limits through Lionton, Kanawha, Wakarusa townships, passing through Leamington, & thence through Grant township into Leavenworth County.
