

Wednesday, April 4 - 1917.

The board met in regular session, with all members present and Commissioner J. L. Hoover presiding.

Claims against the county were allowed as per Allowance Records.

A petition, signed by R. M. Plank & 19 others, asking for the location & establishment of a road, as follows: "By at N.W. cor. of Sec. 10, Twp. 15 S., R. 20 E. Palmyra Twp., Th. east along off a road on the S. side of Sec. 10, 30 ft. wide more or less, 1/2 mile to the 1/4 sec. corner bet. Secs. 3 & 10, Th. E. along off additional width on the N. side, S. side, or both sides of the present road on N. side of Sec. 10 & S. side of Sec. 3, and terminating at the N.E. cor. of said Sec. 10-15-20, Palmyra Twp., Mo." Apr. 26, 1917, was designated as date of hearing, & J. L. Hoover, A. Andrews & M. P. Green named as viewers.

Thursday - April 5 - 1917.

The board met in regular session, all members being present & Commissioner J. L. Hoover presiding.

Claims against the county were allowed as per Allowance Records.

Quarterly reports of the Co. Treasurer, Co. Clerk, Register of Deeds, Probate Judge (Court) & Sheriff were read, audited & approved.

Friday, April 6 - 1917.

The board met in regular session, all members present, and Commissioner J. L. Hoover presiding.

The board directed the clerk to issue a Returning Warrant to Frank Durand, of Leominster township, in the sum of \$1058, upon an order from the State Tax Commission, to adjust an erroneous assessment.
