

Wednesday, April 4- 1917-

The board met in regular session, with all members present and Commissioner J. L. Hoover presiding.
Claims against the county were allowed as per Allowance Records.

A petition signed by H. M. Park & 19 others, asking for the location & establishment of a road, as follows: "Beg. at N.E. cor. of Sec. 10, Th. 15 S., R. 20 E. Galmyr top, th. east laying off a road on the S. side of the line 30 ft. wide more or less, 1/2 mile to the 1/4 sec. corner bet. Secs. 3 & 10, th. E. laying off additional width on the N. side, S. side, or both sides of the front road on N. side of Sec. 10 & S. side of Sec. 3, and terminating at the N.E. cor. of said Sec. 10-15-20, Douglas County, Ia." Apr. 26, 1917, was designated as lot 3 River, & J. L. Hoover, C. Andrews & H. P. Green named as River.

Thursday, April 5- 1917-

The board met in regular session, all members being present & Commissioner J. L. Hoover presiding.
Claims against the county were allowed as per Allowance Records.

Quarterly reports of the Co. Treasurer, Co. Clerk, Register of Deeds, Probate Judge (Court) & Sheriff were read, audited & approved.

Friday, April 6- 1917-

The board met in regular session, all members present, but Commissioner J. L. Hoover presiding.

Claims against the county were allowed, as per Allowance Records.

The board directed the clerk to issue a Refunding Warrant to Frank Davis, of Leomonton township, in the sum of \$1058, upon an order from the State Tax Commission, to adjust an erroneous assessment.

Upon motion of Commissioner Green, seconded by Commissioner Andrews, the action of the board at their regular session held Wednesday, March 7- 1917, in reconsidering their action of the adjourned meeting held Wednesday, February 14- 1917, insofar as said action related to the "canceling of the Robinson estate tax levied by the Deputy Assessor of Grant township, be struck from the record," was reconsidered, and the action then by the board at the ~~adjourned~~ session held Wednesday, February
