

141 was ordered restored as originally adopted. Namely, "that the clerk be instructed to cancel the Robinson estate tax levied in Grant Township, and that the same be stricken off the rolls from that taxing district." This action of the board was taken upon an order from the State Tax Commission, which ruled that the Robinson estate tax was erroneously levied in Grant Township, and that the levying of the tax by the Deputy Treasurer of the City of Lawrence and the subsequent collection by the County Treasurer of said tax was legal & proper.

An order from the State Tax Commission, in regard to the application of the Alpha Xi Chapter of the Sigma Chi fraternity for a cancellation of taxes on the cent 100 feet of lots 3, 4 and 5, and all of lots 8, 9, and 10, in block 5, of Bobber's addition to Lawrence, together with the building thereon erected, was made. In compliance with this order from the State Tax Commission, the board directed the clerk to cause the property above described to be stricken from the assessment and tax rolls of this county, as property exempt by law from taxation, and to abate the erroneous taxes charged upon the illegal assessment, and to distribute the taxes and penalties accrued among the funds for which the taxes were levied in accordance with the rates of levy used for the different funds.

The board, met in regular session, all members present & Commissioner J. A. Hoover presiding.

Claims against the County were allowed, as per Allowance Record.

Commissioner J. A. Hoover announced the receipt by him of a check for \$750.00, from the N. C., N. V. & W. R. R., as rent for use of the bridge across the Kansas river at this point, for the months of April, May & June, 1917. The check was turned over to the County Treasurer, and by him carried into the Special Bridge fund of the County.
