

Thursday, April 19-1917.

The board of County Commissioners met in adjourned session, with all members present and Commissioner J. C. Hoover presiding. On motion of Commissioner Andrews, seconded by Commissioner Green, the board was authorized to enter into a contract with Leavenworth County to pay one-half the bills for repairing the Eudora bridge, in accordance with plans approved by the Public Utilities Commission on March 9, 1917.

Friday, April 20-1917.

The board of County Commissioners met at Leavenworth this date and were present with the board of Commissioners of Leavenworth County when the bills were opened for the repairs of the Eudora bridge across the River. The contract was let to the Leavenworth Bridge Co. at \$7,490.00.

The following contract was agreed to by the boards of Commissioners of Douglas and Leavenworth Counties and signed by the chairmen and clerks of the respective counties, to-wit:

"This contract, entered into this 20th day of April, A.D. 1917, between the board of County Commissioners of the County of Leavenworth, in the state of Kansas, of the first part, and the board of County Commissioners of the County of Douglas, in the state of Kansas, of the second part.

It is remembered, that whereas, the parties to this contract have on the date above mentioned jointly awarded a contract to the Leavenworth Bridge Company for the repairs to and erection of new work on what is known as the Eudora bridge across the Kansas River.

Now therefore, be it agreed by and between the
