

Wednesday - May 16 - 1917 -

The Board of County Commissioners met in adjourned session, all members present & Commissioner J. L. Hoover presiding.

Claims against the County were allowed, for which see Allowance Record.

The fee of M. G. C. Nelson of \$35.00 for professional services in various court cases, unremitted, and in the office of the County Attorney, was rejected.

The claim of the Social Service League, for \$15.00 (and also for \$37.60) as hospital fees, was rejected.

The claim of the Logan-Moore Lumber Co., for \$28.45, for material furnished, was rejected.

Thursday, May 17, 1917 -

The Board of County Commissioners and the County Engineer spent the day in Makarusa and Palmyra townships - in the Second Commissioner district - and Willow Springs and Marion townships - in the Third Commissioner district - on an official road & bridge inspection.

Saturday, May 19 - 1917 -

The Board of County Commissioners met in adjourned session, all members present, and Commissioner J. L. Hoover presiding.

It was moved & carried that the County appropriate an amount in money equal to that which Clinton Township, Douglas County, proposes to appropriate, provided such sum does not exceed \$50.00 from Douglas County, to defray the cost of finding what is known as Sawyer Hill, located in Clinton Township.
