The board of County Commissioners met as a board of Equalization for Douglas County, to hear complaints of property owners as to the assessed valuation of improvements on Real Estate made during the past year & the valuation of personal property as listed by the deputy assessor.

Kanawha township - No complaints, no changes ordered.

Grant township - Upon petition of Mr. W. A. Pinn his personal property valuation was reduced \$105, from a total of \$2,160, to \$2,055.

Tuesday, May 22-1917.

Before adjournment, the board approved of the contract entered into between the Commissioners of Leamington County and the Leamington Bridge Co. for the painting of the Endora bridge. The report of the Commissioners to the Leamington County engineer in the matter is as follows:

"In the matter of the bids for the painting of the Endora bridge we have to report as follows:

"D. H. Young - - - - \$ 899.00

"Leamington Bridge Co. - 750.00 one coat, \$1,050 two coats.

"Thomas Pugh - - - 1,250.00 one coat, \$2,100 two coats.

"F. M. Rubin - - - 1,139.50 one coat.

"Inasmuch as the Leamington Bridge Company has the

"exclusive of the said bridge, all interference of workmen

"will be avoided by awarding contract to said com-

"pany. Two coats of first class paint will be required

"for approval & acceptance of the work by the en-

"gineer.

"The bid of D. H. Young is apparently for one coat.
