Stevenson to cancel the taxes levied against the Continental Church of the Nazarenes of Lawrence, Kans. in the sum of \$41.83, together with the penalty imposed, aggregating \$30.27, and to charge the same back to the funds for which they were levied. The order of the Commissioners was made upon authority of the state Land Commission.

J. E. Smith road petition

The petition of J. E. Smith and 12 others was presented to the board, praying for the location and vacation of a certain road, described as follows: "Beginning about eight rods west of the Washington (met) road on the road in the N.E. 1/4 of Sec. 22, T. 14 S., R. 18 E., running thence in an easterly direction to a point on the east bank of Washington Creek, thence in a southeasterly direction to again intersect the road about one-third the distance up the hill east of the creek. Vacate. To vacate the old road between the above named points."
