

The board thereupon designated the following named persons - J. L. Hoover, W. R. Green, & Allison Andrew, as Viewers, with instructions to meet, in conjunction with the County Surveyor, at the place of beginning in Marion Township, Douglas County, on Friday, the 27th day of July, 1917, and proceed to view said road and to give both parties a hearing.

By direction of the State Tax Commission the board issued the following order, directed to County Treasurer D. C. Stromson:

"By order of the board of County Commissioners, which order was made this date, you are hereby directed to cancel the taxes levied against the Protestant Church of the Nazarenes, of Lawrence, Kansas, lots 57, 58, 59, 86, 87, & 88, Walnut Park Addition to the city of Lawrence, in the sum of \$28.83, & the penalty in said aggregating in the sum of \$30.27, and to charge the same back to the fund for which they were levied."

Claims against the County were allowed, for which see Allowance Record.

The quarterly report of Arthur Northrup showing a total of \$36.80 in fees collected was approved.
