shall be signed by said Chairman and attested by said
Clerk, and the coupons attached thereto shall be ex-
ecuted by the autograph copies of their respective sig-
-natures, and that each bond shall have the impres-
-sion of the seal of the County thereon.

It is Further Resolved by the Board of County
Commissioners that said bonds shall be sold under
the direction of said Board for not less than their
face value, and that no bond shall be delivered to
any purchaser unless the Board of County Commis-
-sioners issuing the same shall receive at the time
of the delivery thereof the full & subsisting outstand-
-ing accounts which are paid by the proceeds of said
bonds.

year there shall be levied a tax on all the taxable
property of Douglas County, Kansas, sufficient to pay the
