

That the E. S. Henry tax of \$1.00, erroneously charged, be cancelled.

That the tax against Mrs. Frances E. Johnson amounting to 9¢, ~~be~~ on account of duplication, be cancelled.

That the tax of \$1.13 against Aubrey Mott, because of no exemption allowed, be ~~cancelled~~ cancelled.

That the tax of \$3.89 against the Western Union Telegraph Co., because of duplication, be cancelled.

That the following allowances, asked for by the County Treasurer, be granted, for the reasons stated:

"Rural High School #1 valuation was too great on account of taking in too much A. T. & S. F. mileage, should be changed to show to the amount of \$40.27.

"The Tax Abstract prepared by the Treasurer shows \$289.18 for sidewalk in Baldwin, when the tax rolls do not show any sidewalk at all, which created an excess charge against the Treasurer.

"Likewise, in transferring from tax rolls to abstract for the Treasurer, 6¢ & 4¢ were due to error.

"Also, owing to changes made in the rolls after the tax was had collected over John's tax, & E. N. S. Bailey's account was increased \$1.00, after Bailey had paid his tax, leaving an apparent shortage of that amount."

The following petition was presented to the Board: "Whereas, there is an encroachment of sand and rocks in the County Road South of the S.W. 1/4 of Sec. 6 - Twp. 15. N. R. 20. W. on which a dirt fill cannot be maintained and which gages out in hole. Therefore, we respectfully petition that you bring the slope to the final grade to be established for this part of the road & enclose the same 16 ft. wide and of sufficient length to cover the encroachment of sand and rocks. If this petition be granted we agree to donate work as set off by our survey. The petition is signed by G. J. Sheffer + 10 others. Action on the petition deferred to a later date.
