

Tuesday, Oct. 9, 1917.

The board met in adjourned regular session, all members in attendance and Commissioner and Chairman J. K. Hoover presiding.

To conform to requirements under the new Highway Law, the board, in conjunction with the County Engineer, designated County roads, as follows:

Begin at the S.W. Cor. of Sec. 20, Twp. 12, Range 20, running north 1 mile, east $1\frac{3}{4}$ mile, thence in a north-westerly direction to the Lawrence County line.

Begin at the north line of north Lawrence at the quarter section corner on the south side of Section 19, Twp. 12, Range 20, running thence north 2 miles, west one-half $\frac{3}{4}$ mile, north 1 mile to Midland, thence north 1 mile to County line, also, from Midland west $1\frac{1}{2}$ mile, thence north 1 mile to the County line.

Begin on the east line of Douglas County at the north-east corner of Section 10, Township 13, Range 21, running west 1 mile, north 80 rods, west 1 mile to Endora townsite.

Begin on the west line of the city of Endora at the quarter section corner of the north-east corner of Section 5, Twp. 13, Range 20, running thence west $5\frac{1}{4}$ miles, thence north 120 rods, thence north-west and west to the east line of the city of Lawrence.

Begin at the southeast corner of Endora townsite, running thence south $\frac{1}{2}$ mile to Silasfield, W. 1 mile, south 4 miles to Black Jack.

Begin at the southeast corner of Section 3, Twp. 15, Range 21, running thence west on old Santa Fe trail $6\frac{1}{2}$ miles to the southeast corner of Baldwin City.

Begin at the south line of Baldwin, running south 2 miles to the Franklin County line.

Begin on the north line of Baldwin, running thence north 4 miles to Linland, west $\frac{1}{2}$ mile, north $1\frac{1}{2}$ miles, north-west $\frac{3}{4}$ mile, north $2\frac{1}{4}$ miles, thence west and north-west $1\frac{1}{8}$ miles to the northwest corner of the County farm, thence north 2 miles, west $\frac{1}{2}$ mile to Lawrence.

Begin at the railroad tracks on West High Street, Baldwin, running west 80 rods, thence north $\frac{1}{2}$ mile, west 2 miles to east line of Willow Springs Township, thence west 14 miles to the west county line. (Old Santa Fe trail road).

Begin at Worden (in Willow Springs township) running south 3 miles to the Franklin County line.
